### PRAY

- Examine one's own life and challenge the objectification of persons and Earth's resources designated for all.
- Say a daily prayer

### LEARN AND SHARE

- Continue to educate yourself and others. Host a workshop or presentation in you local school or parish.

### BECOME A RESPONSIBLE CONSUMER

- Host a fair trade chocolate, coffee and tea tasting party. Use fair trade coffee and tea at home, work, and in places of worship.

### VOLUNTEER

- Volunteer at your local Catholic Charities agency to help serve victims of trafficking as they seek restoration for their lives.

### ADVOCATE

- Engage your elected officials. Ask what they are doing to combat trafficking and press them to take action against this issue in your community and across the nation. Support anti-trafficking legislation at state, national and international levels. (CA SB 1193) - Current bills before Congress

### SUPPORT FINANCIALLY

- Educational, advocacy and support groups that are working to end human trafficking: such as coalitions, safe houses and shelters for trafficked persons,
